By publishing your OA article through the agreement your institution has with RSNA, your research is:

- Immediately available
- Open to increased citations
- More globally visible and accessible
- Available for wider collaboration
- Compliant with OA mandates for funding
- Accessible for interdisciplinary conversation and research

What does the Read & Publish agreement with RSNA mean for your institution?

Immediate, unlimited and APC-free publishing of Open Access research articles by corresponding authors and no barriers to sharing and reuse.

- Greater visibility of research, leading to wider collaboration with peer institutions.
- Wider availability of research, which leads to recognition of your institution as a leader.
